- ✓ Obey County personnel and signs. It is for your safety.
- ✓ Anyone under 16 years of age and pets must remain in vehicle.
- ✓ High visibility safety vest must be worn at all times.
- ✓ Stay within 5 feet of your vehicle while unloading and 15 feet away from heavy equipment.
- ✓ No alcohol, drugs, weapons, salvaging, or loitering.
- ✓ The landfill closes promptly on time. Late customers will be turned away. On-site customers unloading 15 minutes or later after closing will be charged late fees.

Uncovered/Unsecured Loads:

- The Riverside County Department of Waste Resources imposes a surcharge on vehicles entering landfills with uncovered/unsecured loads. Vehicle loads must be secured or covered in a manner which, per the opinion of the Gate Services Assistant, who serves as the General Manager-Chief Engineer's designee, will prevent waste from falling, spilling, or blowing out while the vehicle is in motion. The surcharge will be assessed for all vehicles entering the landfill with an uncovered or unsecured load. The surcharge applies to each site during all hours of operation. The Gate Services Assistants have been given full authorization by the General Manager-Chief Engineer to assess a surcharge for uncovered loads, as described in the policy.

Acceptable and Unacceptable Items

Acceptable Items

- Solid Waste
- Household Refuse
- Yard Trimmings
- Furniture

Acceptable Items with restrictions/limitations

- Tires - Limit 5 passenger/light duty truck tires per day from residential customers only (except El Sobrante).
- Appliances - Limit 4 appliances per day from residential customers only.
- Electronic Waste, TVs, Computers - Only small amounts (at the discretion of the landfill).
- Sharps/Needles - Residentially generated sharps/needles accepted in 1-gallon or smaller rigid plastic containers with a secure lid (Lamb Canyon and Badlands landfill only).
- Treated Medical/Infections waste – Requires Waste Approval.

Unacceptable Items

- Appliances containing ammonia, propane, carbon dioxide (CO2)
- Commercial/Industrial appliances
- Out-of-county appliances, sharps/needles, tires
- Loose sharps/needles
- Commercial/business generated sharps/needles
- Large quantities of E-Waste
- Equipment, commercial, business, and oversized tires
- Hazardous waste
- Household hazardous waste
- Explosives or Ammunition
- Untreated Medical/Infections Waste
- Asbestos (including floor tile and roofing material containing asbestos)
