

Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG) Program

Hazardous waste disposal can be costly and inconvenient. Businesses and government agencies in Riverside County generating less than 27 gallons or 220 pounds of hazardous waste per month (or 2.2 pounds of extremely hazardous waste) are classified as Very Small Quantity Generators (VSQG) as defined in the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 40, §261.5 and the California Health and Safety Code, §25218.1.

VSQG now have a simple and cost effective option to dispose of their hazardous waste. Please visit www.rcwaste.org/hw/business/vsqg for more information and instructions. You will be provided with an estimated cost of disposal, payment procedures, and an appointment for waste drop-off.

Participation Requirements

• Generate less than 220 pounds of hazardous waste or 2.2 pounds of extremely hazardous waste per month.

• Obtain a State EPA ID number from the Department of Toxic Substances Control (https://dtsc.ca.gov/apply-for-hazardous-waste-epa-id-number/).

- · Submit an accurate inventory of hazardous waste.
- Setup an account with the Riverside County Department of Waste Resources for remittance of payment.
- Transport hazardous waste to designated facility by appointment.
