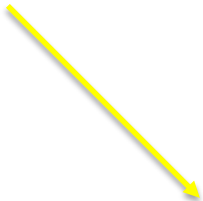
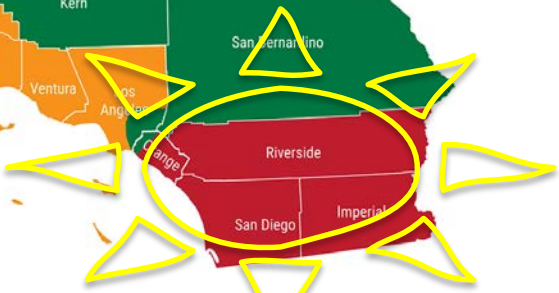
- PaintCare is a non-profit established on behalf of paint manufactures to implement paint recycling programs in states that pass a stewardship law







If you have a large amount of unwanted paint (200+ gallons), PaintCare offers a free service that benefits both you and our volunteer drop-off sites – you don't have to take your paint to a drop-off site a little at a time, and they don't get overwhelmed with large volumes of paint. *This service is only available to households or businesses with at least 200 gallons of paint that are located in a PaintCare state or jurisdiction (CA, CO, CT, DC, ME, MN, OR, RI or VT).*




Non-PaintCare Program Products
